The matter is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the selection of the last selected candidate of JE(Civil) of S.C. Category against the Advertisement No.10/2019 category No.1 vide result dated 06.06.2020 (Annexure P-7).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide his representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr.Rajiv Sidhu, DAG, Haryana has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-9) and decide the

same by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. It is clarified that if the last selected candidate is likely to be affected by the speaking order, he shall be afforded an opportunity of hearing before passing of any such order.
