Paramjit Kaur, has apprised the Court that FIR No.180 dated 18.08.2020, under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; Sections 3 and 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 has been registered in the matter at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous.
