AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that despite being justifiable reasons, as have been sought to be projected by the petitioner with regard to continuing in the official accommodation which he was required to vacate, the said aspect has not been taken into consideration by the competent authority while passing the order dated 02.06.2020 (Annexure P-4).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has submitted a representation/appeal to the Director General of Police, Haryana-respondent No. 2 on 20.06.2020 (Annexure P-7), which has, till date, not been considered nor decided. He asserts that the

representation/appeal submitted by the petitioner dated 20.06.2020 (Annexure P-7) may be considered and decided by the said authority at an early date.

Without considering or going through the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Director General of Police, Haryana-respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the representation/appeal dated 20.06.2020 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
