The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a direction to the respondents issue No Objection Certificate for correction in date of birth of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Department of Water Resources, Punjab, Sector 9, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the representation dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 05.06.2020 (Annexure P-7), expeditiously.

Heard.

Having regard to the prayer made and without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to

respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Department of Water Resources, Punjab, Sector 9, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the representation dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 05.06.2020 (Annexure P-7), within eight weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed, within a period of six weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
