The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No. 106 dated 17.6.2020 on the file of Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana, registered under Sections 323, 325, 427, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC. By way of this petition, he seeks grant of anticipatory bail.

The petitioner and the other accused are alleged to have attacked the complainant, Balwinder Singh, his brother, Lakhwinder Singh, and sister, Mandeep Kaur. The injury attributed to the petitioner is shown to be a simple injury, in terms of the medico-legal report. The co-accused of the petitioner were already granted anticipatory bail, subject to the condition that they join the investigation. That being so, the petitioner would be entitled to similar relief.

The petition is accordingly allowed. The petitioner shall forthwith join the investigation in FIR No. 106 dated 17.6.2020 on the file of Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana. In the event his arrest is warranted in future in relation to this case, the petitioner shall be

released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 50,000/-

along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer concerned. In such an event, the petitioner shall also abide by the conditions prescribed in Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
