HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10.

It is a case in which nobody had represented the petitioner on 26.8.2019 and similar was the situation on 16.12.2019. Even today nobody is representing the petitioner.

As per the contents of the petition, the petitioner had purchased a plot about 6-7 years ago and constructed a house on the said plot and started residing there along with her family members. The husband of the petitioner was convicted in a case registered under Section 302 IPC and was in jail and during that period, dispute of land started and thereafter she moved an application to the police.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Singh, submits that the petitioner started residing in the room of respondent No. 4-

Nirmal Singh and thereafter respondent No. 4 delivered the possession of

entire house to the petitioner and started receiving rent from her periodically. Later on the petitioner started illegal business of immoral trafficking in the rented building and she was asked to vacate the house. He further submits that on 18.4.2017, respondent No. 4-Nirmal Singh along with Satnam Singh, Santokh Singh and other respectables of the area asked the petitioner to vacate the house but she sought one month's time to vacate the same.

Keeping in view the above, no case for issuance of direction is made out.

The present petition is disposed of.
