The instant Petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking Anticipatory Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.186, dated 12.05.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 325, 326 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab to accept notice on behalf of the Respondent/State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to him.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention of the Court to the fact that the alleged occurrence took place on 07.05.2020, but the FIR

(Annexure P-1) lodged was only 5 days later i.e. 12.05.2020.

5. The role attributed to the petitioner is of having assaulted the complainant with a baseball bat on his hand which is non-vital part of the body. The actual injury suffered by the complainant was on his finger and has been designated as a grievous injury within the meaning of Section 325 IPC which is otherwise bailable.

6. In view of aforesaid circumstances and the Petitioner's prayer for Anticipatory Bail is, thus, allowed and he is ordered to be released on Anticipatory Bail subject to his furnishing Personal and Surety Bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
