HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.

The case has been taken up for hearing through
Video Conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of concession of regular
bail in case bearing FIR No.179 dated 25.06.2019 registered
under Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual
Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Chappar, District Yamuna
Nagar.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the
above noted FIR for the reason that he had demanded his salary
dues from the complainant. It is further contended that the
petitioner has been in custody since 25.06.2019 and there is no
head-way in the proceedings before the trial Court. It is yet
further argued that in view of the prevailing situation of

Pandemic Covid-19, there is no hope that the proceedings before the trial Court would conclude sometime soon in near future. Hence, a prayer for releasing the petitioner on regular bail is made.

As pointed out by the learned State counsel, the case is at the stage of prosecution evidence. The victim, while appearing as PW5 has duly supported the version contained in the FIR.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. He, while working as a servant with the complainant (father of the victim), is alleged to have committed the offence with a 7-year old child. The alleged act being a heinous in nature, no case is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
