1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for non-compliance with order Annexure P/1 dated 23.09.2019, in CWP No.27167-2019, which was disposed of in terms of order dated 22.07.2019 in CWP 19940 of 2019.
3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that order dated 24.11.2020, has been furnished to him by learned Addl. AG, Haryana, i.e. decision taken by the respondent in terms of order dated 22.07.2019 in CWP 19940 of 2019 and that in the circumstances he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 24.11.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
4. The same is not opposed by learned Addl. AG, Haryana.
5. Accordingly, in the view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed with the liberty as prayed for.
