The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0001 dated 02.01.2020, registered under Sections 188, 21(1), 4(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) 1957 at Police Station City South, District Moga.

The operative part of the order dated 05.08.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“It is inter alia submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. His identity is not established.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Advance copy of the petition stands served.

At request of learned counsel for the respondent-State, adjourned to 10.09.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 05.08.2020, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from SI Amandeep, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 05.08.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
