The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 289 dated 15.05.2020, registered under Sections 323/506/34 of the IPC and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act, 1989 at Police Station Mujesar, District Faridabad.

The operative part of the order dated 05.08.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“As per allegations in the FIR (Annexure P-1), it was Iqbal Khan, who was carrying a screw driver and the present petitioner along with other persons had attacked and gave beatings to the complainant. As per FIR, petitioner was not carrying any weapon and the injuries are simple in nature.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and seeks time to file reply.

Adjourned to 25.09.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 05.08.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from DSP Dalbir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 05.08.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
