The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 136 dated 16.07.2020 under Sections 306 IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial

interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 05.08.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
