The petitioner avers that he had given some money to respondent No. 4 for purchase of a car and on demand, he refused to return the same. Now, the said respondent No. 4 alongwith respondents No. 5 and 6 are threatening the petitioner that physical harm and injury would be caused in case he demands the money. A detailed representation dated 27.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted before respondent No. 2 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and waives service.

In view of the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to serve the private respondents and filing of written statement is dispensed with.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to take appropriate action upon representation dated 27.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) and pass a speaking order thereupon within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
