MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against private respondent Nos.4 and 5 by arresting them, as they are accused in case FIR No.107 dated 08.07.2020 registered under Sections 376 and 323 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Vario Ke, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1). Further, it has been prayed that a direction be issued to respondents to protect her life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite registration of the case, no action is being taken by the Police. He has further argued that the petitioner is being threatened to compromise the matter and her representation dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) submitted before Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka had failed to evoke any response.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction, as the

FIR has been recently registered on 08.07.2020, which is admittedly under investigation. Apart from it, a perusal of the representation does not make out a convincing ground for issuing directions to provide protection to the petitioner. As per the representation, a bald assertion has been made that the petitioner is being threatened to compromise the matter.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.
