The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to file status report or to arrest respondent No.4 who has been declared proclaimed offender by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal vide order dated 24.07.2017 in Complaint Case No.2398/2016 filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and FIR No.22 dated 07.01.2019 has also been registered under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in Police Station Butana, District Karnala against him.
