All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this application, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner seeks to withdraw the accompanying petition, with liberty to file a fresh one to assail the advertisement dated 29.02.2020 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the applicants (petitioners in the accompanying petition), submits that after the last order was passed in the petition, i.e. on 07.08.2020, he has verified that the rule has actually been amended in 2016 and therefore he seeks to withdraw the accompanying petition, with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action but after challenging the relevant provision/the advertisement itself, since it was misleading, inasmuch as the advertisement incorporated the condition of the unamended rule.

The application is allowed.
