SANJAY KUMAR, J. (Oral)

The grievance of the petitioner in this case is that the transport authorities are not registering his Hyundai Creta 1.6 CRDI Auto SX Diesel vehicle, which is of BS-IV make. According to him, the last date fixed for registration of such vehicles was 31.03.2020 but owing to the nation-wide lockdown declared due to the prevailing Covid-19 pandemic, he could not get the registration completed by the said cut-off date. The petitioner claims to have purchased the vehicle in the year 2019 itself.

Mr. Nitin Kaushal, learned Additional Standing Counsel, appears for the respondent transport authorities. He states on instructions

from Mr. Sanjeev Kohli, Assistant Registering/Licensing Officer, Registering & Licensing Authority, U.T., Chandigarh, that the said authorities have no objection as to registering the petitioner's vehicle subject to his complying with all requisite formalities and conditions. The assurance given by Mr. Nitin Kaushal, learned Additional Standing Counsel, U.T., Chandigarh, is taken on record.

In the light of the statement made on behalf of the respondent transport authorities, there is no necessity to keep this writ petition pending.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of permitting the petitioner to approach the respondent transport authorities and duly comply with all requisite conditions and formalities for registration of his vehicle.

Needless to state, the respondent transport authorities shall be mindful of the assurance given to this Court.
