The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.18 dated 06.03.2020, under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, no

recoveries have been effected him.

Per contra, counsel for the petitioner would contend that there is no such allegation of entrustment to the petitioner herein and the allegation, if any, is against his son, who is already in custody.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 05.08.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
