The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 25 dated 11.02.2020, registered under Sections 306, 34 of the IPC at Police Station City South, District Moga.

The operative part of the order dated 05.08.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“It is inter alia submitted that no offence under Section 306 IPC, is made out against the petitioner, who is the wife of the deceased. Marriage of the petitioner, it is stated was solemnized with the deceased on 31.03.2019 and she had left the matrimonial home on 13.01.2020, as she was subjected to harassment and torture at her in-laws house. A complaint was submitted by the petitioner on 17.01.2020. The petitioner’s husband unfortunately committed suicide on 11.02.2020 in which the petitioner had no role to play.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Advance copy of the

petition stands served.

At request of learned counsel for the respondent-State, adjourned to 10.09.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 05.08.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from the SHO of the police station concerned, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 05.08.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
