Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 10 as they have married against their wishes.

On 05.08.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Daljit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Tanda, District Hoshiarpur has been filed in Court today. As per this reply, it is mentioned that statement of petitioner No.1 Bandana was recorded, wherein she stated that she got married to petitioner No.1 with her free will and they are living happily as husband and wife. They have no danger to their life at present. The petitioners expressed that they do not need any protection from the police.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
