The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.4 dated 16.01.2019 on the file of Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, registered under Sections 307, 353, 186 and 34 IPC (Sections 201 and 120-B IPC added later on) along with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

The petitioner was implicated in the aforesaid offence upon the statement made by one of the co-accused. The prosecution's case is that an attack was launched upon a police party by unknown persons, whose identity was thereafter ascertained.

The investigation in the case has already been completed and the *challan* was presented before the jurisdictional Magistrate. Being members of the police force, the witnesses in the case would not be liable to intimidation. Further, the co-accused of the petitioner has also been granted relief. The petitioner would therefore be entitled to similar relief at this stage.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.4 dated 16.01.2019 on the file of Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Duty/Illaq Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person connected with the case.
