The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.62 dated 03.07.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.

On 05.08.2020, following order was passed:-

*“The case has been taken up for hearing
through video-conferencing.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner
contends that in respect of occurrence dated
26.06.2020, the FIR came to be registered on*

03.07.2020 i.e. after a delay of 7 days. Offence under Section 326 IPC was added later on after 7 days of the occurrence. Applicant/petitioner has been attributed datar blow on the feet of left leg of the complainant. At one point of time, the Court of Sessions granted interim bail to the petitioner vide order dated 21.07.2020 and thereafter, the anticipatory bail was rejected on 24.07.2020. Petitioner could not join the investigation for different reasons as alleged by her. According to the order dated 24.07.2020 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, the injury falling under Section 326 IPC is attributed to the co-accused Nitu Sharma.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr. Sachin Ohri, Advocate appears on behalf of the complainant.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer on 09.08.2020 at 11:00 AM and in the event of her arrest, she

shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner does not co-operate in the investigation of the case, the interim bail shall be cancelled.

Adjourned to 21.08.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and also facilitated recovery of weapon.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh admits the aforesaid position and submits that the petitioner is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 05.08.2020 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
