The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of interim bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.585 dated 29.09.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 201/120-B IPC at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Notice of motion was issued on 11.08.2020 after recording some material facts. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the son of petitioner is suffering from

Thalassemia and has been referred to AIIMS, New Delhi for his Bone Marrow Transplant and further management. Earlier the petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 22.05.2019 passed in CRM-M No.15087 of 2019 for a period of 15 days. Petitioner had availed the said concession and after availing the same surrendered before the Jail Authorities in time.

On 11.08.2020, learned State counsel sought time to verify the medical status of son of the petitioner.

In compliance of the aforesaid order, the State has produced the medical opinion of the Doctor dated 14.08.2020 which reads as under:-

*“As per record Deepak s/o Subhash R/o Sector 6 Jind 8 yrs. Male suffering from Thalassemia major vide IPNO 7100 & UHID a/c 279078 for Blood transfusion. As pt. suffering from Thalassemia major & the only treatment is regular Blood transfusion or Bone Marrow transplant. For B.M. Transplant pt. Referred to AIIMS New Delhi.”*

In view of medical status of son of the petitioner and without adverting to the merits of the case, it would be appropriate to grant interim bail for a period of three weeks.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of three weeks from today, subject to his furnishing heavy bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial

Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
