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**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No 229 dated 6.11.2018 registered under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Maur, District Bhatinda, Punjab.

Custody certificate dated 8.10.2020 has been filed by way of affidavit of Rahul Raja, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Bhatinda, the same is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has actual undergone period including custody as undertrial for 1 years and 11 months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that similarly situated co-accused Gulshan Sharma has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 29.9.2020 passed in **CRM-M No.29202 of 2020** after having undergone a period of 1 year and 11 months of

sentence.

Learned State counsel is not in a position to deny that the petitioner has also actually undergone sentence for a period of 1 year and 11 months.

I see no reason to take a different view. Without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the benefit of bail to the petitioner.

Regular bail to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
