Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.6 to 11 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 03.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, respondent Nos.2 and 3.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 03.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and Station House Officer, Police Station Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur, respondent Nos.2 and 4, to look into the representation dated 03.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
