Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus for the release of detainee, namely, Roshni-minor daughter of the petitioner, who is alleged to have been forcibly and unlawfully detained by respondents No. 4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged detainee, who is minor, has been illegally detained by the private respondents. Moreover, the petitioner has already lodged FIR No. 138 dated 09.07.2020,

registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC, at Police Station Division No. 2, District Pathankot.

On the last date of hearing, respondent No. 4 was ordered to be served through respondent No. 3-SHO, P.S. Division No. 2, Pathankot.

At this stage, Mr. S.K. Choudhary, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 7 and submits that respondent No. 4 and the alleged detainee have solemnized marriage and are living happily.

Today, respondent No. 4 along with his wife, alleged detainee-Roshni, appeared through Video Conferencing. They have been duly identified by their counsel. During interaction with this Court, the couple submits that they have solemnised marriage and are living happily. It is also submitted that a Coordinate Bench has also granted protection to them, vide order dated 15.07.2020.

In view of the above, the present petition having been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
