1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition U/s 438 Cr.P.C. with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move an application for regular bail with a direction being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application for regular bail as and when the same is filed, in a time bound manner.
3. The same is not opposed to by learned Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab.
4. In view of the position as noted above, the petition U/s 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case, any application for regular bail is moved on behalf of the petitioner, before the learned trial Court, the same be considered and decided in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
