The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.228 dated 15.12.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, at Police Station Pillukhera, District Jind, Haryana.

On 10.08.2020, following order was passed :-

“All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks

the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.228, dated 15.12.2019, having been registered at Police Station Pillukhera, District Jind, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the IPC.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to address long arguments on how the certificate would not eventually turn out to be false etc., yet at this stage, in the situation of the current pandemic, suffice to state that undoubtedly the certificate in question is already in the possession of the police and consequently, without making any comment on the merits of the case, notice of motion is issued to the respondent-State, with Mr. Manish Bansal, learned DAG, Haryana, accepting notice at the asking of the court.

Adjourned to 14.09.2020.

In the meanwhile, upon the petitioner joining investigation, in case he is sought to be arrested, he would be admitted to interim bail, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Ilqa Magistrate. He shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

If the arresting officer does not join the petitioner in investigation, he would appear before the learned Ilqa Magistrate immediately, who would then summon the arresting officer and direct him to join him in investigation.”

Mr. Rajat Gautam, DAG, Haryana on instructions from ASI Neel Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 10.08.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
