This appeal has been filed by the appellant-petitioner being aggrieved by an order dated 30.01.2019 passed in CWP-2615-2019, dismissing the petition filed by the appellant against order dated 11.04.2014 whereby the candidature of the appellant has been rejected.

Learned Single Judge has dismissed the petition on the ground of delay and laches on the part of the appellant as his candidature was rejected in the year 2014 and the rejection order was assailed by filing a petition in the year 2019 without giving any acceptable and reasonable explanation for delay and laches. Even before this Court, there is no satisfactory explanation given for delay and laches and in such circumstances, we do not

find any illegality or perversity in the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge warranting interference in it.

The appeal filed by the appellant being meritless is, accordingly, dismissed.
