The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Interim bail was granted to the petitioner by the Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana till FSL report is received in the Court. FSL report has already been received on 06.07.2020. Petitioner did not surrender before the concerned Court despite Court notices issued to him. Now he seeks anticipatory bail without approaching the Court of Sessions for regular bail after surrendering him before the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to rely upon the order dated 25.02.2020 passed in CRM-M No.6448 of 2019, in which the Court while dismissing the petition, directed the petitioner to surrender and seek regular bail. Petitioner has overstayed the period of interim bail and now seeks indulgence of this Court on the basis of recommendations of High Powered Committee for grant of interim bail.

There is no scope for interference in the present petition. The present petition is accordingly dismissed. However, petitioner, if so advised, can avail his legal remedies in accordance with law.
