Prayer in this application is for impleading the accused in the
FIR as parties-respondents No.6 to 16.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed
and the said persons are impleaded as parties-respondents No.6 to 16.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

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It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the
marriage of the petitioner has been solemnized with Satinder Kaur, who is
relative of private respondents. At the instance of the petitioner, FIR No.
221 dated 07.06.2020 under Sections 307/452/506/427/395/148/149 IPC
and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act has been registered at Police
Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran against the private
respondents.

The grievance of the petitioner is to the effect that he is still apprehending danger to his life and liberty at the instance of private respondents. The petitioner has already submitted the representations dated 20.06.2020 and 13.07.2020 contained at Annexures P-5 and P-7 respectively to respondent No.3.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

Without making any comment on the genuineness of the allegations, as put forth in the aforesaid representations, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioners, in accordance with law.
