Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners and the petitioners have been implicated in the FIR in question without there having been any evidence to connect them with the crime. He further contends that they have been behind bars since 19.3.2020, only challan has been presented as a result of which there is no likelihood of concluding the trial in the near future.

Learned State counsel while opposing the prayer of regular bail to the petitioners and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners has apprised this Court that infact the petitioner Sukhwinder Singh @ Rinku Singh in CRM-M-22189-2020 was declared a Proclaimed offender on 2.11.2012 and he could be arrested only on 19.3.2020 and petitioner Lukhwinder Singh in CRM-M-22222-2020 was declared a Proclaimed Offender on 7.9.2015 and he could be arrested on 19.3.2020. He has opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioners in both the petitions in view of the antecedents and conduct of the petitioners.

In the circumstances, no ground for granting the regular bail is

made out.

Both the petitions are dismissed.
