The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.113 dated 17.04.2019, under Sections 323, 498-A, 341, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in response to the direction of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. It is submitted that in fact, during the pendency of these proceedings, the parties have decided to settle their disputes and pursuant to which, petitioner No.1 would be making payment of ₹ 1.5 lacs towards bills that have been raised, apart from making the payment of ₹ 7500/- per month towards the

maintenance of the minor child.

Counsel for respondent No.2 endorses the submissions made by
counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating
Officer, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are
not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the fact that the matter stands compromised between
the parties, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the
petition is allowed and order dated 23.07.201928.05.2019 granting interim
bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down
in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal
Procedure.
