of the Constitution of India, is to the charge-sheet dated 15.09.2017 (Annexure
P-9) and the enquiry report dated 09.08.2019 (Annexure P-12).

After arguing for some time, counsel prays that the present writ
petition be dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to raise all his grounds before
the punishing authority. The petitioner has already submitted to the jurisdiction
of the said enquiry authority which has found one of the charge to be
substantial. Needless to say it is expected that the punishing authority shall
take into consideration whatever grounds the petitioner raises, in accordance
with law.
