The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India alleging violation of the order dated 30.9.2019 passed in CWP-28228-2019 titled as '**Jagmohan vs. State of Punjab and others**'. Operative part of the order dated 30.9.2019 reads as under:-

“Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 8.5.2019 (Annexure P-11), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 08.05.2019 (Annexure P-11), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.”
