The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.413 dated 27.12.2019 registered under Section 379-A IPC at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. Further, it is submitted that even the co-accused from whom the recovery of the snatched vehicle had been made, has been released on bail.

On the other hand, counsel for the State, being instructed by the police official, submits that there are direct allegations against the petitioner. However, it is not disputed that the co-accused from whom the snatched vehicle was recovered has been released on default bail under Section 167 Cr.P.C.

In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
