The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.480 dated 20.06.2020, registered under Sections 21-A/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar.

The operative part of the order dated 07.08.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was nominated in the FIR on the disclosure of one Rajesh @ Khagad, from whom, 07 grams of Heroin were recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the aforesaid recovery was effected from aforesaid co-accused who has been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court on 03.08.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is a lady, aged about 45 years, and she is not involved in any other case.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 07.08.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.08.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
