1 This appeal has been filed against the order of the learned
Single Judge whereby he had declined the interim relief to the appellant.

2 The appellant had challenged the order of the respondent-Govt.
dated 03.07.2020 giving interim charge of the post of Director General,
Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying without any extra
remuneration.

3 Counsel for the appellant has vehemently argued that even the
grant of interim charge to the respondent No.3 is illegal.

4 Notice of motion.

5 On the asking of the Court, Mr. Aman Bahri, Addl. A.G.,
Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that a copy of
the petition had been supplied to him and coincidentally the respondent No.1-
Principal Secretary to Govt. Of Haryana, Department of Animal Husbandry
and Dairying is present. He has obtained instructions from him and had
stated that the impugned order of giving interim charge will not continue
beyond 15 days and on or before 24.08.2020 regular appointment shall be

made to the post of Director General, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Haryana after considering the claims of all the eligible candidates.

In this view of the matter, counsel for the appellant has sought to argue that actually the Govt. is 'hell-bent' on permitting the respondent No.3 even on regular post without him being eligible also. We are afraid we cannot accept this hypothetical argument. It has now been clarified before us that this interim charge is only existing for next 15 days.

6 Consequently, we do not deem it appropriate to proceed further in this case and in case the appellant, or rather anybody else, is aggrieved of any regular appointment made to the aforesaid post of Director General, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, they would be at liberty to raise whatever challenge is available to them.

7 In this view of the matter, this appeal as well as the writ petition filed by the appellant are disposed of.

8 Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.M. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
