Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.70 dated 17.06.2020 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 325 & 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.2, who is attributed injury invoking Section 326 IPC with a sharp-edged weapon.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that allegations against petitioner No.1 are of causing simple injury and there is a delay of two days in registration of the FIR. It is further submitted that the dispute is primarily with regard to right of passage and at the spur of moment, the incident

has taken place.

Learned State counsel could not dispute the factual position and submits that injury invoking Section 326 IPC i.e. injury No.5 is attributed to petitioner No.2.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed and petitioner No.1 is granted anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
