The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0006 dated 3.4.2019 registered under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act and Section 201 IPC at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Hisar, District State Vigilance Bureau, Haryana.

In a trap laid by the police, petitioner was found present and his hands were also washed. The water did not turn pink. No recovery was effected from the petitioner. The sample of water was retained by the police and was sent for analysis on 19.4.2019. As per FSL report, the water was found to be pinkish in colour. The sample remained in the police custody for more than 15 days before sending the same to FSL.

The case appears to be debatable as regards the

complicity of the petitioner. Arrest of the petitioner has been stayed vide order dated 10.5.2019

In view of aforesaid, I deem it appropriate, at this stage, to direct the petitioner to join investigation on 23.1.2020. In the event of his appearance before the Investigating Officer, he shall be granted bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
