This is the second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.172 dated 14.06.2019 under Sections 376(3)/376(2)(N), 376(2)(I) IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Sector-39, Chandigarh.

The earlier petition filed by the petitioner i.e. ***CRM-M-39949 of 2019*** titled as ***Jatinder @ Jatindra Versus State of U.T. Chandigarh and another*** was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated November 14, 2019 passed by this Court.
