GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Pooja and Komal Rani, stated to be aged 21 & 22 years respectively, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 9 and not to interfere in their married life.

By making reference to para 2 of the petition, he further submits that both the petitioners are girls and they are good friends and close to each other, so they decided to marry each other. He submits that in this regard, petitioner No.2 decided to change her harmones from female to male and she is taking treatment from A Beautiful Mind Hospital, CHC-38,

Janakpuri, New Delhi. In this regard, counsel further placed reliance on the judgment dated 20.07.2020, passed by this Court in **CRWP-5024-2020**.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation dated 04.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) was submitted to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-4) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Superintendent of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2) expeditiously, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
