Copy of the affidavit has been placed on record by the petitioner stating therein that now the family of the petitioner has settled the differences with the detinue and promised to marry her as per her wishes at the appropriate time in accordance with their customary rites and traditions.

Since, the detainee is stated to have joined the family, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
