Learned State counsel informs that the petitioner is working as Associate Professor in college cadre and as per the transfer policy, there is no provision of taking any option from him before transfer.

As per short reply filed by the Joint Director, Colleges, Office of Director General Higher Education, Haryana, earlier the petitioner was appointed as Assistant Professor on adhoc basis in the subject of Zoology and he joined at Government College, Narnaul (Mahendergarh) on 22.12.1993. After regular selection as Assistant Professor vide order dated 06.01.1996, he joined in Government College, Mahendergarh. Subsequently, petitioner was promoted as Associate Professor in the subject of Zoology and he joined at Government College for Women, Narnaul (Mahendergarh) on 10.07.2012. Vide order dated 09.01.2018, the petitioner was transferred from Government College for Women, Narnaul to Government College, Kalka, District Panchkula. In the absence of workload, petitioner was allowed to continue in Government College, Kalka

Government College, Kalka and there was no regular person working in Government College for Women, Narnaul in the subject of Zoology, the petitioner was temporarily transferred in Government College for Women, Narnaul vide order dated 28.08.2018. This was a temporary transfer and after the Legislative Assembly elections, vide order dated 01.02.2020 (Annexure P-5), petitioner was temporarily transferred from Government College, Kalka to Government College for Women, Narnaul for four months and this temporary transfer was again extended for three months vide order dated 01.05.2020 (Annexure P-7). Thereafter, the petitioner was relieved on 31.07.2020. He was required to join at Government College, Kalka, from where, he was temporarily transferred earlier.

As per order dated 06.11.2020, the petitioner has now been transferred to Government College, Faridabad.

In the present case, petitioner remained posted in Mahendergarh till 09.01.2018. He cannot be retained at Kalka as there is no workload available now. He has been transferred to Government College, Faridabad keeping in view the workload available in that college, vide order dated 06.11.2020.

In view of the reply filed by the respondents, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to make an appropriate representation before the competent authority, if so advised, in accordance with law.
