The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioners alleging the intentional and wilful disobedience of order passed by this Court dated 04.07.2018 in CWP No.12463 of 2017 (Annexure P/1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the respondents had given an undertaking that the amount payable to the land owners will be disbursed within a period of one month from the date of passing of the order but, despite expiry of two years, no amount has been deposited by the Government of Haryana to be disbursed to the land owners.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pawan Longia, D.A.G, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that he has

instructions from the respondents to submit that the remaining compensation to be given to the land owners, will be disbursed to them within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, hereinbefore, he does not press the present contempt petition any further and the same may be disposed off as such.

The present contempt petition is disposed off as having been not pressed in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents.

It is made clear that in case the undertaking recorded above, is not adhered to by the respondents, a serious view of the matter will be taken by this Court.
