The present complaint was treated as writ petition on a complaint dated 1.7.2020 received by the High Court. Notices were issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into the complaint, enquire and submit his report qua the allegations levelled in the complaint as also to produce the alleged detenu Sarabjit Singh, husband of the applicant before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Today, short reply by way of affidavit of Dhruvan H. Nimbale, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, has been filed stating therein that "the matter was enquired into and it has been found that the petitioner has moved the complaint dated 1.7.2020 due to some misunderstanding and this fact has been further corroborated the statement of the husband of the petitioner namely Sarabjit Singh son of Inder Singh, resident of village Malmohri, district Tran Taran recorded in the Area Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, District Tran Taran, wherein it has been admitted by the husband of the petitioner that he never remained in the police custody rather he had gone Gurdawara Sahib for paying obeisance from where he returned to his home in the evening on the same day. It has been further stated by him that somebody falsely informed his wife(petitioner) that he has been

taken away by the police and is in police custody and further the husband of the petitioner has stated to the extent that his wife being illiterate wrongly filed the writ in the Hon'ble Court and same is false.”

In view of the above, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed accordingly.
