The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging the intentional and wilful disobedience of order dated 07.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP No.143 of 2020 (Annexure P/1). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no order has been passed by the respondents on the legal notice dated 30.06.2019 as directed by this Court vide order dated 07.01.2020 passed in CWP No.143 of 2020 (Annexure P/1) so far, despite, the time granted by this Court has already elapsed.
