Mr. Arjun Dev-appellant has appeared in person and states that he has resolved the dispute with his brother Mr. Om Parkash-respondent No. 1. He, in fact, states that all the brothers have resolved their dispute and he does not wish to proceed with the present appeal. Deed of compromise signed by the parties to this litigation has been filed. The appellant has also produced copy of his Aadhaar Card as well as Senior Citizen Identity Card. Photocopies of the aforesaid identity cards are being kept on the file. The deed of settlement is taken on record as Mark 'C'.

Mr. Om Parkash, the only contesting respondent is also present in person and has also filed a photocopy of his Aadhaar Card. He admits the correctness of the settlement Mark 'C'.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of deed of compromise, which shall form part of the decree.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the abovesaid judgment.
