GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Daljeet Kaur, stated to be aged 41 years, has filed the present petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* with a prayer for directing respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and further directing respondent No.3 not to harass her by calling in the police station time and again.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Sitta, Asst. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, based on the pleadings, submits that for the allegations mentioned *inter alia* in the petition, with

specific reference to Para Nos.2 & 3, the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 14.03.2020 (Annexure P-4 colly) to the Station House Officer, P.S. Ajitwal, District Moga (respondent No.3). Initially, based on the representation, a report/rapat has been registered on 27.04.2020, but, thereafter, he submits that no action has been taken.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction to that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned, with representation with regard to her alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Station House Officer, P.S. Ajitwal, District Moga (respondent No.3), within three months from today, expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Station House Officer, P.S. Ajitwal, District Moga (respondent No.3), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
