Prayer in this writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members, at the instance of respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that petitioner No.2 is the Sarpanch of the village and they are holding the said post for the last many years and under political pressure, the petitioners are being threatened to involve them in false cases. It is further submitted that the petitioners have already given a representation (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) and the petitioners may be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the concerned official to look into the grievance of the petitioners.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioners and decide the representation

(Annexure P-3), in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
